While Château Clarke's wines are today firmly rooted in the Médoc, the estate's name recalls a much older story. Acquired in 1771 by the Irish knight Tobie Clarke, the property has carried this name through the centuries.

Revived in 1973 by Edmond de Rothschild as a true family project, Château Clarke embodies a vision driven by passion and commitment. On a rare clay-limestone terroir, an unusual choice of Merlot on the Left Bank gives rise to wines of precision, elegance and freshness: Château Clarke and Château Clarke Le Merle Blanc — two resolutely contemporary expressions of the Médoc.

At Château des Laurets, the ambition is to bring together generations around a shared pleasure: wine. Benjamin de Rothschild, son of Edmond, sought to continue the family's pursuit of an exceptional estate, acquiring the property in 2003 to reveal its full richness and potential. On a remarkable terroir, beneath the gaze of a château with a striking silhouette and its unmistakable octagonal tower, a singular expression of Saint-Émilion Merlot now emerges — powerful yet profoundly elegant, the fruit of inherited expertise and a vision of wine conceived as a shared experience.
